The 2010 Twilight Players Club is designed to introduce new golfers to the game as well as offer value to the current recreational golfer and their families.

**Included:**

- Pay no green fee after 3pm Daylight Savings Time & 1pm non-DST. Pay only appropriate cart fee when used at these times.
- Receive the Green Fee rate of \$60 wkday and \$72 wkends and holiday prior to the 3pm DST & 1 pm non DST. Cart rental required before noon Fri., Sat., Sun. and Holidays but can walk.
- 15% discount off merchandise in Pro Shop excluding sale items & Golf Clubs
- Cart rental reduced to \$22.00, \$17.00 at 12pm (Non-DST); 2pm (DST)
- Additional Family Members added for \$125 per person per month.
- \$175 per month

**PROGRAM CONDITIONS:** The Twilight Players Club is an annual program ending on 12/31/2010 that is paid with monthly dues of \$175.00 charged by the 5<sup>th</sup> of each month. Minimum commitment is 3 months. Membership privileges apply to members only. To use the facility under the conditions as stated, you must have your Players card and proper identification with you at all times. Also, a discount of 15% is offered in the Golf Shop on all items except for sale items and golf clubs. During the daylight savings time, members may play after 3:00pm any day without paying a green fee. During non-daylight savings time, members may play after 1:00pm without paying a green fee. Members may play before these times at the green fee rate of \$60.00 on weekdays and \$72.00 on weekends and holidays. Member is responsible for paying appropriate cart fee when used and rental will be reduced to \$22.00 and \$17.00 at 12pm (Non-DST); 2pm (DST). Cart rental is required before noon on Fri., Sat., Sun. and Holidays but can walk. In the event of a tournament, maintenance practices, or weather conditions, the golf course may be restricted, limited, or even closed for play.

**CANCELLATION POLICY:** You may elect to cancel the program, but must do so in writing via letter or fax no less than 30 days prior to the next billing cycle. If you discontinue your membership within the first 30 days of enrollment, you will be charged a cancellation fee of \$300.00. If you decide to rejoin the program within the same year, there will be an assessment of \$300.00 for back dues plus the current month's dues. Once cancelled, member will be required to return their membership card to Bayonet and Black Horse Golf Club.

**Adding a family member** – Please add a family member to my account. Family member must be of the immediate family; living at home. I hereby authorize Bayonet Black Horse Golf Courses to charge an additional \$125 per family member per month to my credit card. In the event the primary member wishes to cancel and the family member wishes to continue, the family member rate will increase to full rate and he/she will become the primary.

## **BAYONET / BLACK HORSE CLUB RULES**

1. The Executive, Associate, and Twilight Players Club membership programs are granted on a calendar basis. Renewal of these memberships is at the sole option of Bayonet Black Horse Club, referred to as “the club” from here on. These memberships shall be limited, as the club from time to time deems appropriate. Memberships cannot be transferred or encumbered in any manner and privileges automatically terminate upon Applicant’s death.
2. The club will establish an annual fee or monthly dues in such amount as it deems appropriate for Executive, Associate, and Twilight Players Club members. The annual fee for the Executive or Associate Member shall be paid to the club when submitting application. The initial monthly dues for the Twilight Players Club Program shall be paid to the club when submitting application.
3. Executive, Associate, and Twilight Players Club members must have a starting time reserved through the golf shop. The staff shall assign the starting time depending on availability. All members and guests must register in the golf shop before beginning play and pay appropriate fees, if any, that are assigned to their particular membership. Picture ID and Membership card must be presented at time of check-in. A 24-hour notification is required to cancel a starting time. Members who fail to do so will be required to pay for those starting times.
4. Guest privileges, if any shall be established by the Club from time to time and may vary from season to season or be withdrawn at the discretion of the Club.
5. Executive, Associate and Twilight Players Club members shall be liable for any property damage or personal injury caused by member or guests during use of the Club and / or its facilities. Members shall indemnify and hold the Club and its agents, employees, directors, officers, shareholders and partners, harmless from any and all liability, including damages, costs, expense, and reasonable attorney fees occurring on or arising out of activities upon the Golf Course or its facilities.
6. Executive, Associate, and Twilight Players Club members shall be entirely responsible for his or her own safety and that of members’ guests and the property of each while on the premises and during their use of the Club and its facilities. Members expressly assume and acknowledge the risk of any injury or damage while using or on the golf course and related facilities and, except as precluded by California law, expressly waive any right or claim to bring any cause of action against the owners of the golf course the Club or any of their employees, officers, agents, members, associates or partners for any or all damage or personal injury or property damage of any kind sustained during the use of the Club and / or its facilities.
7. The Club reserves the right to terminate an Executive, Associate or Twilight Players Club membership at any time either for cause or without cause. If an Executive, Associate or Twilight Players Club membership is terminated without cause, the Club will provide a refund of the unused portion of his / her annual fee or monthly dues.  
If an Executive who pays monthly or a Twilight Players Club member elects to resign or cancel their membership, they must do so in writing via letter or fax no less than 30 days prior to the next billing

cycle. If they resign or cancel their membership within the first 30 days of enrollment, they will be charged a cancellation fee. If they decide to rejoin the membership within the same year, there will be an assessment fee charged prior to continuing paying dues for the contracted year. If an Executive who pays monthly dues or a Twilight Players Club member is terminated for cause, then no part of his / her monthly dues will be refunded for the current month and their annual contract canceled.

“Cause” is defined as willful disobedience of Club Rules or violation of California law.

If an Associate or Executive member elects to resign or cancel their membership or application; or if an Associate or Executive member is terminated for cause, then no part of his / her annual fee will be refunded, but may be retained by the Club as compensation, including for processing such transaction.

8. The Club Facilities shall be open on the days and during the hours as may be established by the Club. The Club management in its sole discretion, reserves the right to restrict or close the Club's Facilities including the Golf Course for course renovations, scheduled maintenance, repairs, championship events, tournaments and or special events.
9. Executive, Associate, and Twilight Players Club Members and their guests may not abuse any of the Club's employees, verbally or otherwise. All service employees of the Club are under the supervision of the Club Manager and no member or guest shall reprimand or discipline any employee, nor shall a member request an employee to leave the Club Facilities for any reason. Any employee not rendering courteous and prompt service should be reported to the management of the club immediately.
10. Relation to membership: To the extent any Rule contained herein is, or may be interpreted as inconsistent with the terms of membership, conditions and disclosures contained in application for the Executive, Associate, or Twilight Players Club membership, the application will be controlling.
11. In the event of any dispute between the parties hereto, the prevailing party shall be entitled to reasonable attorney's fees and costs.
12. Any dispute between the parties hereto shall be submitted to binding neutral arbitration before an arbitrator mutually agreed upon between the parties. If unable to agree on the arbitrator, the presiding judge of Monterey County shall appoint one. All disputes shall be settled or arbitrated in Monterey County, California, which shall be the exclusive venue for all disputes.
